



The word "Plaz" is a modernized, gender-neutral adaptation of "Plaza," which means "town square" internationally, borrowed from Spanish. It is cognate with many related terms across different languages, including plateia, platz, place, piazza, plaça and ploschad, all of which refer to shared public spaces




INTEROPERABILITY
